## How to reset WGdashboard access credentials

The administrator username and password is stored on your server in the following configuration file: /wgdashboard/src/wg-dashboard.

You can reset the credentials to the default admin/admin by following these steps:

- 1. Connect to your server via SSH
- 2. Execute the following command (you can paste it into your SSH client):

```
\label{local_section} {\tt sed -i '2 c\backslash username = admin' /wgdashboard/src/wg-dashboard.ini \&\& sed -i '3 c\backslash password = 8c6976e5b5410415bde908bd4dee15dfb167a9c873fc4bb8a81f6f2ab448a918' /wgdashboard/src/wg-dashboard.ini && systemctl restart wg-dash } \\
```

- 3. Wait for WGDashboard to reset (it should take under a minute).
- 4. Head over to your WGDashboard page, and use "admin" for both the uername and password.
- 5. Once logged in, change your username and password, as per the Wireguard template instructions.
